Scholars who are selected through National Eligibility tests – CSIR – UGC NET including lectureship (Assistant Professorship) and GATE. b. The selection process through National level examinations conducted by Central Government Departments and their Agencies and Institutions such as DST, DBT, DAE, DOS, DRDO, MHRD, ICAR, ICMR, IIT, IISc, IISER, etc.  Preference will be given to candidates with experience in water quality studies and knowledge of local conditions.	Data Collection, field visits and water quality monitoring in East Jaintia Hills District, Meghalaya, processing and analysing of data, preparation of maps and analysis in GIS environment for the entire duration of the project.

**1. Service Conditions:**

- (i) DA: JRFs will not be entitled to DA.
- (ii) House Rent Allowance: JRF is entitled to HRA as per Central Government norms applicable in the city/location where he/she is working. The percentage required for calculating HRA will be based on the fellowship amount.
- (iii) Medical benefits: JRF will be entitled for medical allowance as applicable in Water Resources Department, Meghalaya.
- (iv) Leave and other entitlements: JRF is entitled only for casual leave. Participation of the JRF in scientific events/workshops held in India or abroad will be treated as "on duty" with

- due approval of the host institution. The travel entitlement for participation in scientific events/workshops in India will be 2<sup>nd</sup> AC by rail.
- (v) Bonus & Leave Travel Concession: JRF will not be entitled to these allowances.
  - (vi) Retirement benefits: JRF will not be entitled to these benefits.
  - (vii) Publication/Patent: The result of JRF research work may be published preferably in standard referred journals with the concurrence of the fellow and his/her Supervisor/Advisor. It should be ensured by the fellow that the assistance provided by the funding agency of Government of India is acknowledged in all such publications.
  - (viii) Obligations of JRF:
    - (a) He/She shall be governed by the disciplinary regulation of the host institute where he/she is working.
    - (b) The JRF must send a report of the research work done during the period of fellowship as may be asked by the sponsoring agency.
2. **Age Limit:** The upper age limit is 28 years on the day on which application is made relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST/OBC candidates as on the date of the interview.
  3. Only Indian citizens are eligible to apply.
  4. The award of research fellowship does not imply any employment guarantee by Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, RD&GR, Govt. of India or Water Resource Department Meghalaya or Central Pollution Control Board.
  5. The engagement is neither an employment nor an assurance for the employment. The term of engagement would be coterminous with PDS in case of foreclosure of PDS.
  6. In relation to emoluments, leave, project duration, etc. the conditions would be as per DST guidelines.
  7. The appointment is for the period of study which is to be conducted from 2019-20 to 2021-22 (tentatively).
  8. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for attending the interview.
  9. The decision of the competent authority will be final and binding in all respects.
