

Micro Irrigation

Micro Irrigation (Drip & Sprinkler) is a concept which has recently been taken into consideration in our State and has been included for the first time in the Annual Plan 2004-2005. It is supposed to cover small areas which may even have only single family beneficiaries. Also small gravity flow diversion projects at micro-level are also being implemented to irrigate small areas having potential areas with adequate water sources. Such projects are expected to deliver early benefits to the farmers instantaneously due to early completion. Moreover, the farmers are expected to take care of the operation and maintenance by themselves.
